The **13th Physical Oceanography Dissertation Symposium** (PODS) will be held in Lihue, Kaua'i, Hawai'i from **19-24 October 2024**. This symposium is for recent graduates or soon to graduate, physical oceanography related PhD-level scientists interested in pursuing a career in academia or research laboratories. The attendees will present their research in front of their professional peers and representatives from some of the federal agencies funding physical oceanographic research, and have the opportunity to forge professional relationships that will facilitate their future research and academic careers.

This symposium is jointly supported by the National Science Foundation, the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, and the Office of Naval Research, and coordinated by the University of Hawai'i.

Applicant Information: Participation in the PODS symposium is by invitation only to applicants who have completed a dissertation concerning an important problem in ocean physics. Dissertations must have been completed after **30 June 2023**, or applicants must provide certification from their Department Chair or Dean that they will complete their degree by **1 July 2025**. The deadline to apply is **26 April 2024**. Applications received by that date will be reviewed by a screening committee and invitations issued by **early-July 2024**.
